



Beyond Covid @ FedUni - OctoberVET

The 'Beyond COVID' OctoberVET, November 25th 11.00am-12.30pm.

This event will be presented by Federation University's research group RAVE (Researching Adult and Vocational Education and Training).

It's important to use research to understand what is happening with CO VID, but we also need to look beyond it. So some presentations are mainly or partly COVID-based, and others deal with ongoing VET, adult education and employment issues. This is Ballarat's fourteenth OctoberVET event.

The keynote speaker is Gary Workman, Executive Director of the Apprentice Employment Network; His presentation, 'Apprenticeships: What would it take', draws on recent research by the Apprentice Employment Network aimed at encouraging employers to engage with more non university job seekers to meet their growing skill shortages via apprenticeships. It includes analysis of the current apprenticeship environment and recent history, including the effects of COVID.
